

BEER CAN SAILING INFORMATION

1. A minimum of two boats must start for it to be considered a race and scored. All sail boats are welcome to participate.
2. When the race course consists of only one mark, boats may round to port or starboard.
3. Races are held on Saturdays at 12:30 pm and Wednesdays, at 6:30 pm, depending upon the time of year. Consult the Beer Can schedule for details.
4. Races are run from the south veranda and utilize a standard 5 minute starting sequence with both flags and sounds.
 - 5 minutes prior to start – Class flag goes up – gun sounds
 - 4 minutes prior to start – Prep flag goes up – horn sounds
 - 1 minute prior to start – Prep flag comes down – horn sounds
 - Start – Class flag comes down - gun sounds
5. There are two classes which will be scored separately, Hops for spinnaker boats and Barley for non-spinnaker. Spinnaker boats get their standard rating, while non-spinnaker boats get a club rating.
6. The first boat across the line gets a gun, other finishers a horn.
7. Race results are posted weekly on the Beer Can Page.
